## Defend Freedom On September 11

The insanity of the New World Order is indoctrinated into the American “sheeple” by more means than just through the medium of television. If we manage to organize a successful major protest and it fails to convince Washington and Tel Aviv to rethink the attack, then more persuasive concrete actions will be our only option for the day after the attack upon Iran

If we cannot do this simple thing together, then we will be the last witnesses to human freedom.
